## Table Protector Installation Guide

Follow the instructions below based on your table surface for the best appearance and grip.

### Glass Tables

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|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 1. Clean the glass thoroughly using glass cleaner and a microfiber cloth.                   |
| 2. Lightly mist the glass surface with clean water.                                         |
| 3. Place the transparent table protector onto the wet surface.                              |
| 4. Align all edges and corners carefully.                                                   |
| 5. Use a squeegee or soft card wrapped in microfiber to push water and air bubbles outward. |
| 6. Allow 12–24 hours for any remaining moisture to disappear.                               |

**Tip: If preferred, a light dusting of talcum powder can be used instead of water for easier positioning.**

### Wooden Tables

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|------------------------------------------------------------|
| 1. Ensure the table is completely clean and dry.           |
| 2. Place the protector directly on the tabletop.           |
| 3. Align the edges and corners.                            |
| 4. Smooth the cover gently from the center outward.        |
| 5. The protector will naturally settle within 24–48 hours. |

**Tip: Do not use water on wooden surfaces.**

### Marble & Stone Tables

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| 1. Wipe the surface clean and dry.                        |
| 2. Place the protector directly on the marble.            |
| 3. Align all edges evenly.                                |
| 4. Press gently to remove trapped air.                    |
| 5. Let the cover settle naturally over the next 24 hours. |

**Tip: Avoid placing very hot cookware directly on the protector. Always use trivets or heat mats.**

### General Care

- Clean using a soft microfiber cloth.
- Use mild soap and water for regular cleaning.
- Avoid dragging sharp objects across the surface.
- Use coasters or trivets for hot utensils.

- Allow the protector to relax naturally after unpacking.
